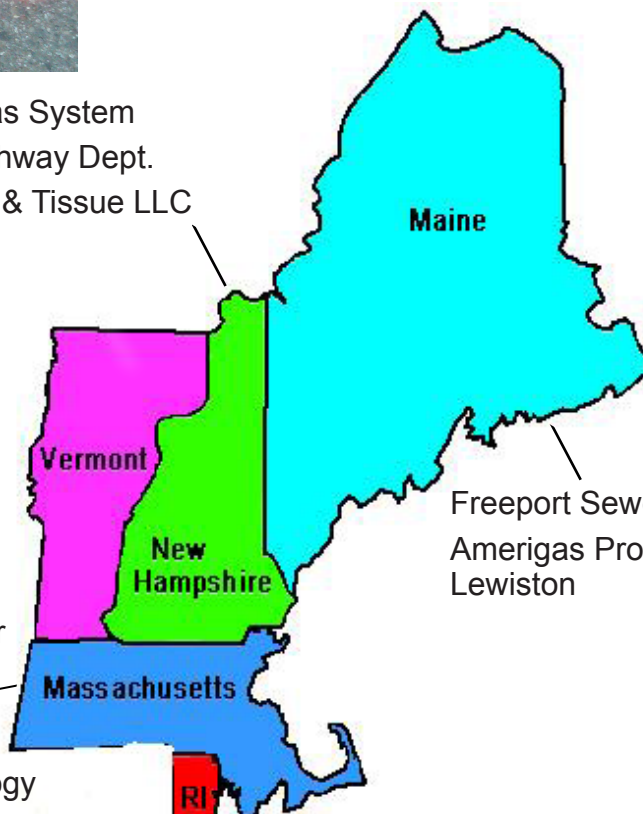

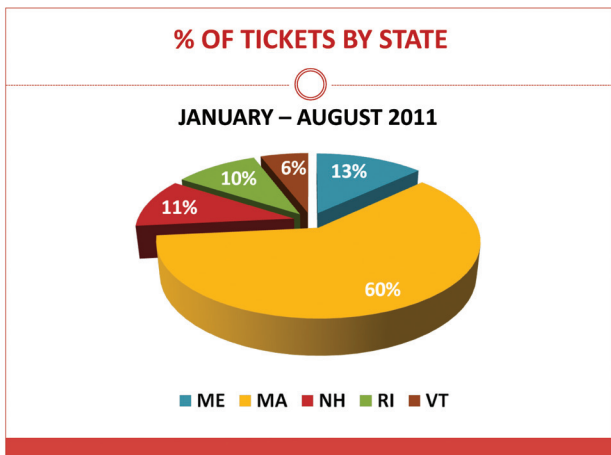

Even small, shallow excavation jobs can be a risk if you don't know where underground lines are buried.

Remember to call 811 for every project

#### Step 1

"Pre-mark" where you plan to dig before making the call to 811.

Pre-marking means to mark out the area on the ground where the work will take place, using white stakes, paint or flags.

When utility company representatives arrive to mark their lines, pre-marking provides a visual to help guide them in placing their marks where you need them, and not where you don't.

#### Step 2

Gather the information we need to process a locate request.

#### Step 3

Call 811 in advance



Our call center is open from Monday through Friday from 6:00am to 6:00pm.

State law requires you give at least 72 business hours notice in Massachusetts, Maine, New Hampshire and Rhode Island; 48 business hours in Vermont.

Weekends and [legal holidays](#) do not count toward your start date.

You will be given a Dig Safe ticket number as proof of notification.

#### Step 4

Notify any non-member facility operators if known. Non-member companies are not notified by Dig Safe. See our [Laws at a Glance](#) chart on to find out what types of utilities companies are required to be members of Dig Safe.
